The wines included on this list use sustainable, organic or biodynamic practices in the vineyard and/or winemaking process.

☼ **SUSTAINABLE WINERY** - Designates that this winery's practices are not only ecologically sound, but also economically viable and socially responsible.

☼☼ **ORGANIC GRAPES / WINE** – Designates that this wine uses certified organically grown grapes, avoiding any synthetic additives, or Organic Wines are made from organically grown grapes, and are also made without any added sulfites (though naturally occurring sulfites will still be present).

☼☼☼ **BIODYNAMIC WINEGROWING** – Similar to organic, in that both take place without chemicals, but biodynamic farming incorporates ideas about a vineyard as an ecosystem, accounting for things such as astrological influences and lunar cycles. A biodynamic wine also means that the winemaker did not make the wine with any common manipulations such as yeast additions or acidity adjustments.

INTERESTING WHITE WINES

- ☼☼**214 STERLING Sauvignon Blanc**, Mendocino, 2009 **34.00**
Clear pale straw and offers aromas of lime, guava and a hint of fig. The flavors are a bright, mouth filling medley of ruby grapefruit, lemon lime and tropical notes of guava, papaya, and passion fruit.
- ☼**219 PONZI Pinot Blanc**, Willamette Valley, 2009 **39.00**
Citrus blossom, honeydew melon and ruby grapefruit define the nose of this wine. The mouth has a full spicy entry with hints of pear leading to a beautiful bright finish
- ☼**213 KING ESTATE DOMAINE Pinot Gris**, Oregon, 2008 **45.00**
This juicy, impressively filled Pinot Gris has strong themes of white peaches with complexing accents of jasmine and hints of wet stones. It is full and slightly rounded in feel with balancing acids tempering its slight residual sweetness.
- ☼☼**245 BONTERRA Chardonnay**, Mendocino, 2009 **34.00**
Made in the Bonterra style of exceedingly pure fruit, this Chardonnay brims with delicious tangerines and pears. It has pretty acids that make it feel clean in the mouth. A delightful wine made even richer with a touch of new oak
- ☼**247 BENZINGER Chardonnay**, Sangiacomo Vineyard, Carneros, 2008 **39.00**
Made in the modern, ripe style. The wine is dry and crisp and minerally, with a clean mouthfeel, yet offers rich flavors of pineapples, green apples and peaches.
- ☼☼**221 BONTERRA Rosé**, Mendocino, 2009 **25.00**
This blend is from three locally cultivated grapes: cherry from our Sangiovese, raspberry and pepper from Zinfandel and a burst of bright alpine strawberry from Grenache to complete the experience.
- ☼☼☼**222 AMPELOS CELLARS Viognier**, Santa Ynez, 2009 **49.00**
This Wine is juicy, vibrant and rich. Nose is perfumey and powerful but not over done, with offerings of Meyer lemon, peach, tangerine and honeysuckle. The palate has a long finish with bright acidity.
- ☼☼**200 PACIFIC RIM Riesling**, Columbia Valley, 2009 **34.00**
Aromas of jasmine and citrus. The subtly sweet profile is balanced by bright and refreshing acidity.

Aromas of Bing cherry, cassis, currants & raspberry, with spicy notes of cedar & dried cranberry and slight vanilla. In the glass you'll find juicy red berry flavors & a very approachable, rich & full mouthfeel with a lingering, finish.
- ☼☼**315 PAUL DOLAN** Mendocino County, 2007 **45.00**
A terrific Cabernet...In fact, you could place it next to far more expensive Napa bottlings. It's dry and elegantly tannic and complex, showing blackberry, currant, violet, herb and cedar flavors that bring to mind a fine Bordeaux
- ☼☼**288 LONG MEADOW RANCH** Napa, 2005 **69.00**
This is an example of a lighter, drier style of Cabernet that maintains great elegance and charm. It's very dry, showing blackberry, black currant, herb and cedar flavors wrapped into firm tannins, and brightened with crispness
- ☼**287 LANGTRY** Tephra Ridge Vineyard, Lake County, 2005 **85.00**
This vineyard's high elevation creates wines with intense aromas, structure & longevity. It is dark & inky, aromas of cassis, blackberry, mint & spice. It is full-bodied, complex & rich with firm, ripe tannins & a long smoky finish.

- ☀️**376 ISOSCELES BY JUSTIN** Paso Robles, 2005 **169.00**
Dark, dense garnet robe. Inviting scents of maple, plum and brown sugar. Velvety tannins and juicy flavors of blueberry, mocha and black cherry followed by secondary nuances of graphite and minerals. Hints of cedar and dust in the lingering black cherry-driven close. 78% Cabernet Sauvignon, 15% Cabernet Franc, 7% Merlot

Packed with deep, dark berry fruit and nuanced hints of cocoa, herb and earth with a soft structure. Its velvety texture makes this Merlot instantly appealing and an obvious alternative to similar, more tannic Bordeaux varieties.
- ☀️**414 STERLING Merlot**, Three Palms Vineyard, Napa Valley, 2005 **65.00**
Vibrant black-garnet hue. Heady aromas of new leather, Hershey's dark chocolate syrup, black cherry and peppermint. Lovely plum and cherry-chocolate flavors impart a defined mintiness.
- ☀️**422 ANNE AMIE Pinot Noir**, Cuvee A, Willamette Valley, 2008 **45.00**
Aromas of black cherry, red raspberry, lavender, chocolate and sweet tobacco. Flavors of licorice, anise and black cherry. Has a nice long smooth silky, chocolate finish.
- ☀️☀️**480 MORGAN Pinot Noir**, Double L Vineyard, Santa Lucia Highlands, 2006 **89.00**

Intense aromas of black fruits with accents of anise & vanilla. The palate is bright & juicy, with flavors of black cherry, raspberry & plum. A dash of black pepper accompanies fresh acidity on a long, structured finish.
- ☀️☀️**499 YALUMBA Shiraz**, South Australia, 2009 **35.00**
Aromas of plum, cherry, mulberry, violets & forest floor fragrances. A medium bodied wine delivering flavours of plum, all-spice, blueberries & hints of almond kernel. This wine has plush soft tannins & a bright juicy finish.

VERITE WAS INSPIRED BY THE IDEAL OF MARRYING THE CLASSIC APPROACH OF THE FRENCH VIGNERON (WINEMAKER) WITH THE EXQUISITE POTENTIAL OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA FRUIT. PIERRE SEILLAN BRINGS MORE THAN 30 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AND INTIMATE KNOWLEDGE OF VINEYARDS AND WINEGROWING TO THE PROCESS OF HAND-SELECTING INDIVIDUAL VINEYARD BLOCKS ACROSS KEY GROWING REGIONS.

THESE BLOCKS, OR *micro-crus* AS PIERRE REFERS TO THEM, WERE SELECTED BASED ON DIVERSE CRITERIA OF SOIL, CLIMATE AND ASPECTS SPECIFICALLY FOR THEIR POTENTIAL TO EXPRESS A STRONG SENSE OF TERROIR. IN THE WINERY, PIERRE COAXES FROM EACH *micro-crus* TO PRODUCE FINISHED WINES THAT RETAIN THEIR OVERALL SENSE OF TERROIR, BUT ARE MORE BALANCED AND ELEGANT THAN ANY OF THE INDIVIDUAL COMPONENTS MIGHT BE ON THEIR OWN.
