## INTERESTING WHITE WINES

- 219 WORK Sauvignon Blanc** Napa, 2005 **90 pts WE** **27.00**  
No oak touched it, but it was stirred on the lees, which gives the citrus and tropical fruit flavors a rich, creamy texture. This is a polished, sophisticated Sauvignon Blanc.
- 245 DUTTON-GOLDFIELD Chardonnay** Rued Vineyard, Russian River, 2005 **95pts WE** **79.00**  
Extraordinarily ripe fruit, high acidity, a terroir-driven minerality, and lots of new French oak. The flavors are of tropical fruits, the ripest white peaches and vanilla cream, baked into spicy pastry crust.
- 247 BARNETT VINEYARDS Chardonnay** Sangiacomo Vineyard, Carneros, 2007 **91pts WE** **59.00**  
Ripe, lush and immediately attractive, this Chard offers rich tiers of pineapple custard, pear marmalade, vanilla, buttered toast, toasted coconut and Asian spice flavors. It's a strong, flamboyant wine that calls for equally strong foods, like lobster.
- 207 MELVILLE Viognier** Napa, 2005 **94pts RP** **24.00**  
Boasts a sumptuous bouquet of honeysuckle, orange marmalade, litchi nuts, and apricot jam. It exhibits surprising minerality along with great precision & intensity, & a long finish.
- 201 CONUNDRUM BY CAMUS** Napa, 2006 **88pts WS** **59.00**  
Floral and aromatic, with peach, nectarine and spicy melon flavors that are intense and vivid, lingering on the finish. Has a fleshy texture and refreshing acidity. Sauvignon Blanc, Muscat Canelli, Chardonnay and Viognier.

## CABERNET SAUVIGNON

- 350 KENWOOD ARTISTS'S SERIES** Sonoma, 2003 **87pts WE** **89.00**  
The '03 is elegant and sleek, with blackberry and cassis flavors that finish thoroughly dry.
- 272 BERINGER** Knights Valley, Sonoma Coast, 2006 **90pts WN** **39.00**  
Inky black with a garnet rim. Shy aromas of plum and leather. Creamy flavors of blackberry and blueberry. Velvety tannins and hints of maple and vanilla in the blackberry-infused close.
- 324 NOVELTY HILL** Columbia Valley, 2006 **92pts WS** **49.00**  
Dense and chewy, but with a nice lift of acidity and freshness as the finish rolls in, framing the cherry, blackberry, coffee and smoke flavors as they linger expressively.
- 299 GLEN CARLOU** Paarl, South Africa, 2006 **90pts WE** **27.00**  
The nose starts with a delicate aroma of minerals, black currant and spice, and on the palate, layers of anise, cracked pepper and clove. Sturdy tannins and a vibrant overall fruit profile gives the wine a lift. Overall balanced and smooth.
- 344 SBRAGIA** Andolsen Vineyard, Dry Creek Valley, 2006 **90pts RP** **69.00**  
The outstanding 2006 Cabernet Sauvignon Andolsen has a small amount of Cabernet Franc in the blend. It's deep ruby/purple color is followed by aromas of tobacco leaf, underbrush, white chocolate, black currants, and loamy soil.

- 375 DRY CREEK THE MARINER** Dry Creek Valley, 2005 **87pts WE** **75.00**  
This is tight, showing cedary oak, currant, sage and mineral notes that are full-bodied, with drying oak flavors. Cabernet Sauvignon, Merlot, Petit Verdot, Malbec and Cabernet Franc.
- 510 TANDEM** Peloton, California, 2004 **87pts WS** **59.00**  
High-toned, juicy wild berry and blackberry fruit is intense and vivid, with good acidity and a clean, fruity aftertaste. Pinot Noir, Zinfandel, Chardonnay, Carignane, Syrah and Gewürztraminer.
- 484 SHAFER** Firebreak, Napa, 2003 **90pts RP** **85.00**  
The medium dark ruby/plum-tinged 03 Firebreak offers up a fragrant perfume of strawberries, kirsch, leather, earth, herbs, and spice. Spicy on the tongue, with a lovely texture, fine purity, and good length. Sangiovese & Cabernet Sauvignon.
- 509 ROLF BINDER** Heinrich, Barossa Valley, 2004 **91pts WE** **49.00**  
Light on its feet. Dances across the palate with berry, pomegranate and rhubarb, picking up sweet spice and fresh orange peel notes on the expressive finish. Shiraz, Grenache and Mataro.

- 401 CANOE RIDGE** Columbia Valley, 2003 **89pnts WS** **52.00**  
Firm, with a juicy beam of blackberry and black olive flavor shining through the chewy tannins, lingering on the nicely focused finish.
- 416 PARADIGM** Oakville, 2004 **90pnts WS** **89.00**  
Well-structured and focused, with ripe plum, spice and cedar aromas and black cherry and mocha coffee flavors that take on richness and tannins on the finish. Drink now. 830 cases made.
- 327 RAYMOND** Reserve, Napa, 2004 **87pnts WE** **49.00**  
Rich and forward in cherry, blackberry, coffee and smoky oak flavors, this has ripe and fine polished tannins. It's a nice wine, with some sharpness on the finish.

## PINOT NOIR

- 435 BUENA VISTA** Carneros, 2006 **88pnts WE** **35.00**  
Shows wonderfully ripe, pure Pinot Noir fruit flavors, with black and red cherries and currants elaborated with exotic Asian spices and sweet, smoky sandalwood. Very tasty and elegant now.
- 431 DELOACH ESTATE** Russian River, 2007 **92pnts W&S** **45.00**  
Ripe raspberries lift from the glass and mingle with tempting aromas of strawberry-rhubarb tart and cola. Delicate notes of anise, cardamom and gingerbread spice lace the fruit to unfold a rich palate of black cherries.
- 433 LANDMARK** Grand Detour, Sonoma, 2006 **89pnts RP** **65.00**  
light to medium ruby with sweet pomegranate, earth, and kirsch-like notes, the wine is sensual, medium-bodied, but silky, lush, and a total delight to drink, this is a hedonistic Pinot Noir.
- 444 MUELLER** Emily's Cuvee, Russian River, 2003 **93pnts WS** **89.00**  
Fragrant rose petal and crushed raspberry aromas turn elegant and stylish on the palate, with fresh, lively acidity and a sleek, rich aftertaste. Wonderful balance, finesse and delicacy.

## ZINFANDEL

- 456 DRY CREEK** Old Vine, Sonoma, 2004 **87pnts WE** **59.00**  
Dark and dramatically rich, with blackberry jam, cherry-pie filling, milk chocolate and cinnamon spice flavors, this polished wine has gorgeously fine tannins.
- 478 ROSENBLUM** Snows Lake Vineyard, Lake County, 2005 **91pnts RP** **69.00**  
Boasts a dark ruby/purple hue along with floral, blueberry, & boysenberry characteristics interwoven with black currant, camphor, earth, & oak notes. With crisp acidity, sweet tannin, & a long, heady finish
- 457 TURLEY** Rattlesnake Ridge, Howell Mountain, 2007 **92pnts RP** **84.00**  
Reveals a more floral character intermixed with black fruits, crushed rocks, blueberries, and graphite. It is another impressive, elegant yet full-bodied, powerful Zinfandel.
- 485 SEGHEIO** Sonoma, 2007 **93pnts WS** **49.00**  
This seductive and vigorous Zinfandel offers smoky black cherry and blueberry aromas that lead to youthful wild berry, sage and cracked pepper flavors, with a lingering finish and zesty tannins.

## INTERESTING REDS

- 502 D'ARENBERG** Footbolt Old Vine Shiraz, So. Australia, 2006 **90pnts RP** **54.00**  
Aromas of dark red fruits, black olive and beef stock open into notes of blueberries and licorice with a savory dried herb edge. The palate shows great balance with blueberry and mulberry fruits, spices and a hint of white pepper on the finish.
- 489 CONSILIENCE** Syrah, Santa Barbara, 2005 **88pnts RP** **39.00**  
Possesses a fat, fleshy personality that is very much in keeping with the estate's signature. Its dense purple hue is accompanied by copious quantities of black fruits interwoven with hints of new oak and char.
- 508 FESS PARKER** Syrah, Rodney's Vineyard, Santa Barbara, 2004 **91pnts WE** **69.00**  
This is a rich, syrupy wine, with concentrated fruit based on blackberries and spice, made more complex by hints of coffee, earth and grilled meat.
- 500 CLARENDON HILLS** Syrah, Moritz Vineyard, Australia, 2004 **92pnts WS** **84.00**  
Big and rich, but surprisingly graceful, with lavish raspberry, rhubarb and cherry flavors that linger beautifully. Picks up meaty, gamy notes on the finish, wrapped in a veil of polished tannins.

# VÉRITÉ

## Philosophy

VERITE WAS INSPIRED BY THE IDEAL OF MARRYING THE CLASSIC APPROACH OF THE FRENCH VIGNERON (WINEMAKER) WITH THE EXQUISITE POTENTIAL OF NORTHERN CALIFORNIA FRUIT. *PIERRE SEILLAN* BRINGS MORE THAN 30 YEARS OF EXPERIENCE AND INTIMATE KNOWLEDGE OF VINEYARDS AND WINEGROWING TO THE PROCESS OF HAND-SELECTING INDIVIDUAL VINEYARD BLOCKS ACROSS KEY GROWING REGIONS.

THESE BLOCKS, OR *micro-crus* AS *PIERRE* REFERS TO THEM, WERE SELECTED BASED ON DIVERSE CRITERIA OF SOIL, CLIMATE AND ASPECTS SPECIFICALLY FOR THEIR POTENTIAL TO EXPRESS A STRONG SENSE OF TERROIR. IN THE WINERY, *PIERRE* COAXES FROM EACH *micro-crus* TO PRODUCE FINISHED WINES THAT RETAIN THEIR OVERALL SENSE OF TERROIR, BUT ARE MORE BALANCED AND ELEGANT THAN ANY OF THE INDIVIDUAL COMPONENTS MIGHT BE ON THEIR OWN.
